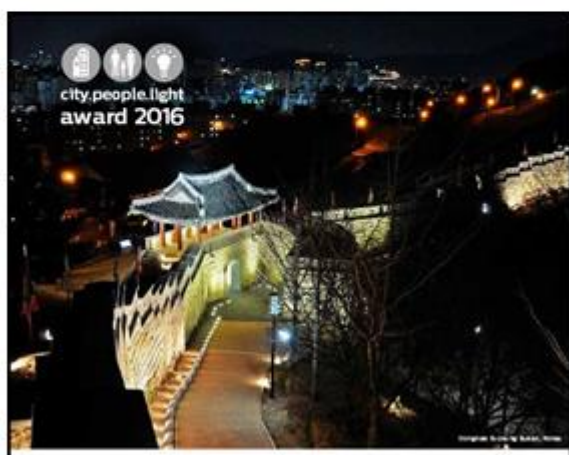




Applications open for the city.people.light awards 2016

The contest is open to urban lighting projects that have been completed less than two years prior to entry in the contest. Application deadline: 12 August 2016.
