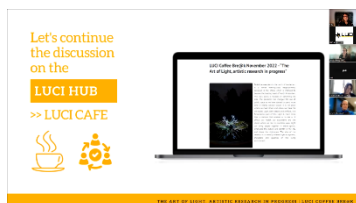

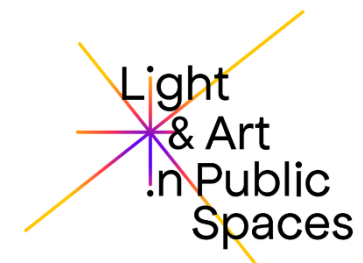


Turin: Luci d'Artista is in full swing
