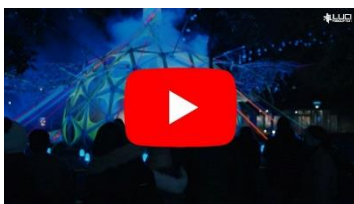




## LAiPS project partners meet in Amsterdam + Rotterdam 🌐
