



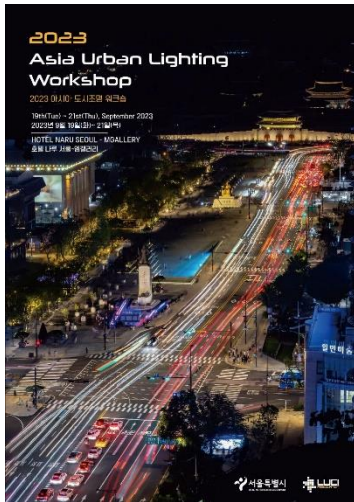
Bringing life to public spaces with Light Art - 2-3 Nov 2023 📅

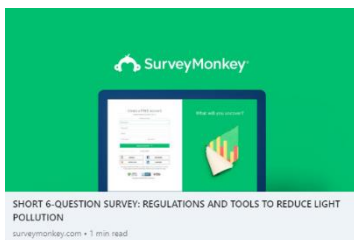

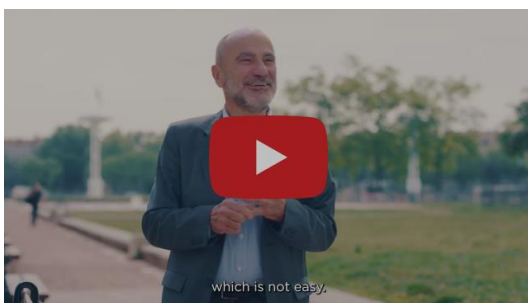
